






International Charity Day is celebrated annually on 5th September, 2024. The students of S.B. Patil Public School celebrated it on the 18th of the month via a special assembly.



कर मूले तु गोविन्दः, प्रभाते करदर्शनम्

इसका अर्थ है कि लक्ष्मी जी (धन की देवी) हाथ के शीर्ष पर वास करती हैं, सरस्वती जी (ज्ञान की देवी) हाथ के मध्य भाग में विराजमान हैं और भगवान गोविंद (कृष्ण) हाथ के मूल में निवास करते हैं। इसलिए, सुबह के समय हाथ का दर्शन करने से यह विशेष देवी-देवताओं का आशीर्वाद मिलता है। यह श्लोक शुभ प्रार्थना और आध्यात्मिक संदेश का प्रतीक है।

"कराग्रे वसते लक्ष्मीः" - यहाँ "कराग्रे" का अर्थ है 'हाथ के शीर्ष' या 'हाथ की अग्रभाग'। इसका अर्थ है कि धन की देवी लक्ष्मी हमेशा हाथ के शीर्ष पर वास करती है, यानि धन का प्राप्तिकरण कार्य के आरंभ में होता है।

“करमध्ये सरस्वती” – यहाँ “करमध्ये” का अर्थ है ‘हाथ के मध्य’। इसका अर्थ है कि विद्या की देवी सरस्वती हमेशा हाथ के मध्य में वास करती है, यानि विद्या का प्राप्ति स्थान मध्यम में होता है।

“करमूले तु गोविन्दः” – यहाँ “करमूले” का अर्थ है ‘हाथ की जड़’। इसका अर्थ है कि ईश्वर का ध्यान करने के लिए हमें हमेशा हाथ की जड़ की ओर देखना चाहिए। गोविन्द का अर्थ है ‘कृष्ण’।

“प्रभाते करदर्शनम्” – इसका अर्थ है कि सुबह के समय हाथ का दर्शन करना चाहिए। यहाँ “करदर्शनम्” का अर्थ है ‘हाथ का दर्शन’।

इस श्लोक का सारांश है कि हमें सबसे पहले ईश्वर का ध्यान करना चाहिए। इसके बाद ही हम धन और विद्या की प्राप्ति कर सकते हैं। इसी तरह, सुबह के समय हाथ का दर्शन करने से इस विचार को याद रखना चाहिए कि हमें सबसे पहले ईश्वर की शरण में जाना चाहिए।

A Review of Special Education, A Book by Dr. Anupriya Chadha

Published in 2018, this book aims at providing an insight about Attention Deficit Hyperactivity Disorder (ADHD), the author has tried to cover details on how children with ADHD are different in nature and can be dealt with in a normal way and can be imparted with general education with minimal efforts from the surroundings e.g.: parents, teachers, colleagues etc. The author has also provided examples of ADHD behavioral traits which help the reader to understand the gravity of each trait and ways to identify and deal with the same.

The book also covers the history of inclusive education and the need to empathise with the same and how far we've come from the days of exclusion to today's inclusive practices, legal milestones, and the support systems we have in place.

The book also has various teaching-learning material for children with ADHD, which shall help educators to understand the subject well and deal with these students effectively by solving some quick exercises and be well prepared for some similar things going around in their classroom.

Certain challenges that educators have been faced throughout the journey are:

1. Lack of parental support.
2. Lack of appreciation.
3. Lack of support from co-workers.

Since these children can be distracted easily and can create chaos for rest of the learners, there are ways in which the behavior of these children can be controlled when at school / institute.

1. Instructions must be shared in a way that they can understand.
2. Allowing them breaks when needed.
3. Using A/V techniques for their better understanding.
4. Setting up a routine for them not breaking it easily, as constant changes can break their momentum

The book gives insight about certain rules that the Right to Education Act mandates, along with the RPWD Act, that no child can be denied admission to any educational institution on account of their disability, learning or otherwise, and neither can they be discriminated against. a school-counsellor (for behaviour management at home and school).

If a child has ADHD, he/ she may need additional special services such as a classroom aid, private tutoring, special classroom settings, or, in rare cases, a special school. It is important to remember that once ADHD is diagnosed and treated, children with it are more likely to achieve their goals in school.


