

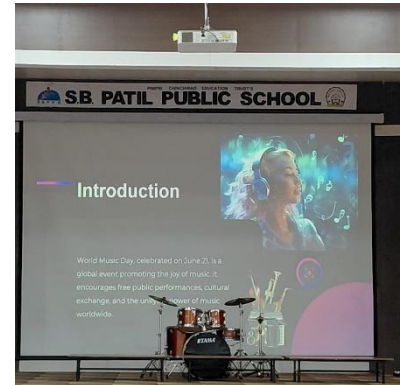
Where Words End, Music Begins: Celebrating World Music Day
